Page 211. "In this order of things, Monsignor Montini headed section II of the Secretariat, in charge of the day to day conduct of the Holy See's international affairs. More important in this context, Montini had under his supervision the Vatican bureau that issued the refugee travel documents and the Caritas Internationalis, the Church's international welfare organization, which at the time, and for some years after the war, was one of the main charitable institutions aiding the fugitive Nazis!

"1949, Caritas aided Dr. Hans Hefelmann, one accused at Euthanasia Trial, with travel documents and money to Argentina."

Page 241. "Around 1947, the department of the Vatican's Secretariat of State helped displaced persons under the direction of Monsignor José Montini, whose assistant, Monsignor Guiseppe Siri, was the link for the escape of Martin Bormann to Argentina.

Set up during World War I Assets upward of \$3 billion. No balance sheets. Huge: sums moved around the world.

Transferred this money between belligerents during WWII.

SA, SPECIAL ADMINISTRATION OF HOLY SEE PROPERTY
Dated from 1929, the year Mussolini paid \$2.4 million,
advised and assisted by J.P.Morgan, Hambrose Bros. of London, and Rothchilds of Paris.

### SGI, SOCIETA GENERALE IMMOBILLAIRE,

Vatican money that became highly diversified. Rome Hilton, Pan Am Building, Champs Elysees, Paris, Watergate Complex, Washington, D.C. (\$60,000,000., and the Stock Exchange in Montreal, Canada.

PECA, PREFECTURE OF ECONOMIC AFFAIRS

Montini brought in "career diplomat Cardinal Vagnozzi, who had spent nine years in Washington, D.C. arch conservative."

FATHER MARCINKUS, CHICAGO, ILL, appointed by Montini, Pope Paul VI, to be salaried to IRW.
